 Under Criterion II of Teaching – Learning and Evaluation

RESULTS AND DETAILS

Student Satisfaction Survey was conducted on 12th September 2019 based on 112 random sampling:

- A. 98.79% of the students confirmed that this was their first time answering the survey.
 17.54% confirmed that this was their second time answering the survey.
 8.88% did not mention whether it was their first time or second time.
- B. The survey was answered by 57.72% female students and 56.61% male students.
 8.88% did not tick the male or female options.
- C. The survey was answered by --- of the students pursuing Bachelor of Arts (more enrolment) and --- of the students pursuing Bachelor of Business Administration.
