One Day workshop on National Education Policy (NEP) 2021 was organized by the Department of Education on Date 11 September 2020 with Prof.T. Lhungdim, Former Head and DSW Department of Education, Rajiv Gandhi University, and Prof. (Dr.) Rakesh Rai, Head of Department, Education Department, Nagaland University as the Resource Person.

The workshop was conducted in 2 sessions where in the first session, Prof. T.Lhungdim focused on the "Prospect and challenges for Teacher".

He highlighted on the different challenges and the role of the teachers that were highlighted on the NEP 2020. He mentioned that, NEP 2020 has put in place systematic reforms that would help in restoring the high respect and status for teachers and further stated that, with NEP 2020, the National Curriculum Framework for Teacher Education (NCFTE) will soon put into practice to guide the teachers.

The 2<sup>nd</sup> Session was led by Prof.Dr. Rakesh Rai where he focused on the topic "NEP 2020 for Higher Education". He spoke on the overall changes that were mentioned on the NEP 2020 with relate to Higher Education. He mentioned on the Flexibility of the new framework.

He also mentioned on the Current problems faced by Higher Education in India as well as in North-East, and further state that, with this NEP 2020, educational system will focus towards a more Holistic and multi-disciplinary Education. The workshop ended with an interactive session where doubts were cleared.
