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ACTION TAKEN REPORT 2023

The analysis of the Feedback provided by the teaching faculty depict largely positive responses that have provided valuable insights. There were also several areas of concern where responses were either "Disagree" or "Not Sure". These have been addressed during the monthly faculty review meeting. The following outlines the primary concerns and actions taken:

	FEEDBACK CONCERN/ISSUES	ACTION TAKEN
1.	Syllabus is suitable to the course – 35% were neutral and 17% disagree on this statement.	The College is affiliated to Nagaland University and thus follows the guidelines and Curriculum provided. There are two faculty as members of Board of Studies, Management who do give valuable inputs. The other faculty also give suggestions to their respective department BoS concerning syllabus and curriculum.
2.	The system followed by the Nagaland University for the design and development of curriculum is effective – 64% were neutral on this statement.	The departments are encouraged to give suggestions and feedbacks to their respective Board of Studies, Nagaland University.
3.	The College is able to attract meritorious students – 35% were neutral and 17% disagree on this statement.	The quality of students taking admission have improved over the years. We are able to attract better students comparing to few years back. The College is putting on efforts to attract meritorious students by providing free admission for toppers in the HSSLC.
4	The teachers are supported with adequate learning resources – 47% were neutral and 23% disagree on this statement.	There are smarts board and smart TVs installed in some of the classrooms, in the seminar hall and in the conference room. There is also continuous book addition in the library after taking reference from all the departments concerned.
5	The administration is sincerely putting efforts for the development of the institution – 17% were neutral and 23% disagree on this statement.	Incremental developments are an ongoing process depending on resources available. A new Volleyball court was recently built. A new academic block is constructing which will house the main library, more classrooms, language lab, computer lab, day care centre, information centre, medical unit, seminar hall.

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
