ACTION TAKEN REPORT 2023-24

- 1. The NAAC Second Cycle completed successfully and C-Edge College was graded B with 2.45 CGPA.
- 2. Parents Guardian Teachers Conference 2023 was held successfully on 18 October 2023. There were 35 parents/guardians who turned up and 25 completed feedback forms were collected from them.
- 3. NSS members and students successfully participated at the World Cleanup Day on 16 September 2023. This was part of the College community work.
- 4. Free Entrepreneurship Training for the students was successfully conducted by Mini Tool Training Centre Nagaland from 25-29 September 2023.
- 5. As part of the MOU process, Faculty Exchange Programme was successfully conducted between C-Edge College and Unity College on 25 October 2023. This was initiated by the Department of Sociology.

 - Key Indicator no. 1.4 Feedback System is graded as 0 (zero).
 - Key Indicator no. 3.3 Research Publication and Awards is graded as 0 (zero).
 - Key Indicator no. 5.2 Student Progression is graded as 0 (zero).
- 4. Dr. Chubatola Aier mentioned that the IQAC submitted the Appeal on 2 May 2023. Thus, the College was permitted and scheduled to present the appeal on 29 May 2023 with a virtual meeting with 82nd Appeals Committee (NAAC). On 23 June 2023, based on the recommendation by the Appeal Committee and approved by the EC (Executive Council) of NAAC, it was declared that there is no change in the CGPA and Grade Awarded. Hence, the Second Cycle of Assessment and Accreditation for C-Edge College stands at 2.45 CGPA with B Grade.
- 5. She also mentioned that despite everything, the CGPA was better than the College first NAAC first cycle and that we should continue to work towards providing quality education to the younger generation and hope for a much better grade in the next cycle.
- 6. The Coordinator of the IQAC, Wapanginla Ao expressed her gratitude to all the members and the other stakeholders for their constant support during the NAAC second cycle process.
- 7. Discussion on activities and events for Anti-Ragging and Anti-Sexual Harassment, Gender Equity and Sensitivity was put forward by the IQAC Coordinator, which will be put forward during the monthly faculty review meeting.
