

ACTION TAKEN REPORT 2024

From the feedback analysis, it is found that most of the students are satisfied and the feedback is quite positive. Due acknowledgement is to be given to the faculty, staffs and the College management and authority for delivering their best for the continuing process towards quality sustenance. Feedback issues and concerns were discussed in the faculty review meeting and during the Quality

Feedback issues and concerns were discussed in the faculty review meeting and during the Quality Workshop session. Actions were taken accordingly towards improvement. The following are some of the issues and concerns from the Feedback and the action taken:

FEEDBACK CONCERNS/ISSUES	ACTION TAKEN
In the additional comments, a few students have suggested that there should be more options in AECC, SEC and VAC papers.	- As per Nagaland University regulations, AECC is a mandatory component. Meanwhile, opportunities for SEC (Skill Enhancement Course) and VAC (Vocational Ability Course) will be explored for future consideration
Majority of the students find the internal assessment "Sometimes Unfair".	Our college acknowledges that student satisfaction may vary. To ensure fairness and transparency in evaluation, the College have put in place the following procedures: Internal marks are displayed on the notice board in two phases for student review. Chances for improvement are given to the students. Moderation Meetings are held with departments before internal marks are finalized and submitted to the University
Students in BA II (38%), BA IV (51%) & BA VI (52%) had marked that only 70% to 85% of the syllabus was covered in the class.	- During the Monthly Faculty Meeting, a comprehensive review of syllabus coverage and course progress was presented and discussed. Faculty members reported a 100% completion rate of the syllabus. To ensure seamless course implementation, additional measures include: - Maintaining Logbooks and Lesson Plans - Suggested to regularly updated students on completed topics and units, ensuring they remain informed about syllabus progress.
There were a few suggestions for some faculty members to improve their teaching process.	 College management and the Principal engaged in a collaborative Departmental Meeting to tackle pressing faculty concerns, optimize departmental operations, and promote institutional excellence.
Suggestions were also given to provide Wi-Fi service in Library for students; and for lectures to be more interactive using PowerPoint presentations.	 In this regard, desktops with Wi-Fi facility is already made available for students use in the Library. Smart board and TVs are being installed in the classrooms in a phased manner for more interactive classes. Teachers have been impressed upon to upskill on teaching strategies and use of ICT tools for more effective learning.
