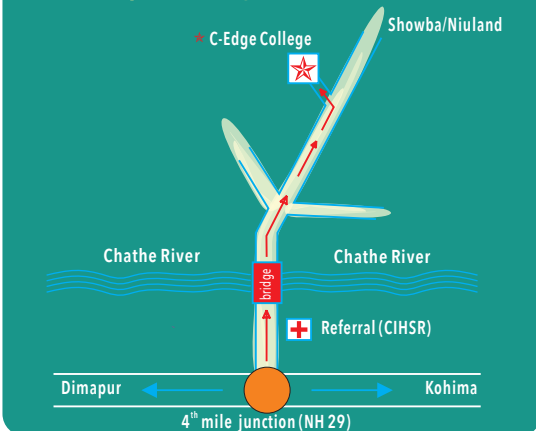

ADMISSIONS:

Eligibility for B.A. & B.B.A

- Higher Secondary or equivalent examination.

When and How to apply?

- Admission process starts soon after the declaration of HSSLC results.
- Filled in Application Forms are to be submitted in the College Office on or before the specified date along with all necessary documents.
- Students shall be admitted as per seat availability on the basis of merit. Submission of Application Form is NOT an assurance for admission.

Documents to be submitted at the time of Admission.

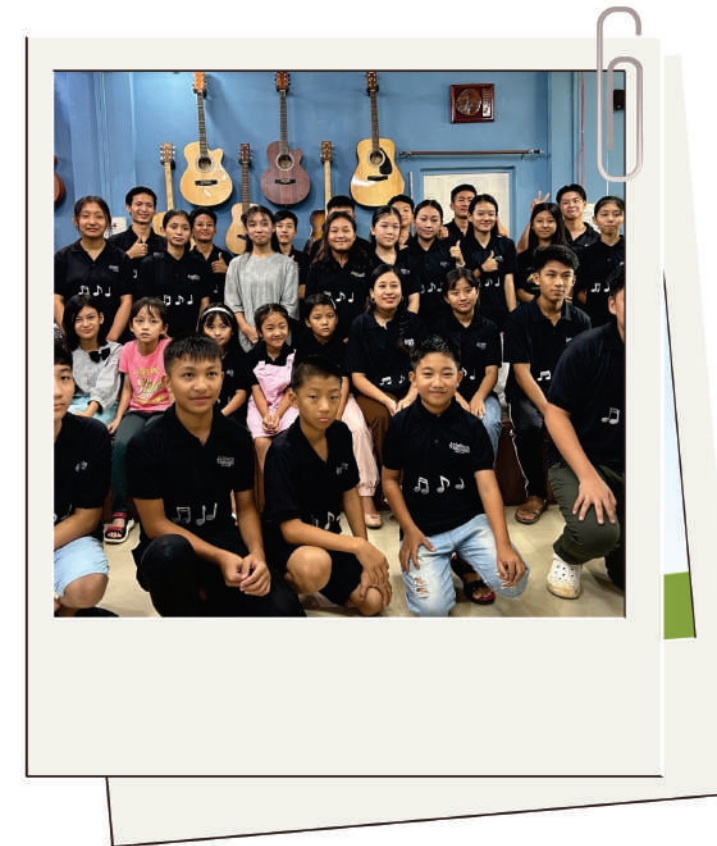
- Self attested copies of marksheet (1 copy), Admit Card (1 copy) and 2 nos. of recent passport size & 1 no thumb size photo (in light background).
- Original marksheet should be produced at the time of interview/admission and on admission. This shall be kept in the College Office and returned after completion of the course.

FYUGP (Four Year Undergraduate Programme) - NEP 2020

- Nagaland University has introduced the Four Years Undergraduate Programme (FYUGP) from May 2023 following the NEP 2020. Under the FYUGP, students must pass both the internal assessment and the external exams. The minimum pass marks for both internal and external is 40%. The close correlation between Contact Hours and Credits has made regular attendance a critical component, students are expected to maintain requisite attendance to be eligible for the prescribed credits.

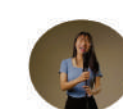
